- Expanded on Grounds lab research for essential activity starting June 1, 2020.
- Currently we have safely opened:
- Over 400 labs
- Brought back over 2300 researchers back to work
- Approximately 1000 of which are graduate students.
- Experienced undergraduates back in labs -in planning

- Manning Fund for COVID-19 Research \$1.9M gift for supporting research focused on testing, therapies, vaccines, and ways to reopen society.
