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

- Refinanced \$300 million of existing debt portfolio
- Identified 45 opportunities for finance system improvements
- Created framework and improved 15 processes, including University capital construction program




#### **Thirty Years of State Appropriation and In-State (College) Undergrad Tuition** (in 2020 dollars)





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### Changing Relationship Between State Appropriation and Tuition In Funding Educational Costs




### **2019-20 Private University Tuition & Fees (Top 25 USNWR) vs. UVA In-state Tuition, Fees, and General Funds**






## October 2003 BOV Resolution to Pay Nationally Competitive Faculty Salaries

- The University historically measures its average faculty salary as compared to AAU peers.
- In 2000, the University ranked 21<sup>st</sup> among AAU peers.
- In 2003, after three consecutive years of no salary increases, UVA's average faculty salary fell to the 30<sup>th</sup> position of AAU peers.
- In October 2003, the Board approved a resolution to restore faculty compensation to nationally competitive levels by the end of fiscal year 2007, defined as returning to the top 20 of AAU peers.



#### 2018-19 UVA Faculty Salary vs. Top 30 AAU Peers



## **2020-2021 Operating Challenges and Opportunities**

- Potential Commonwealth budget reductions (5% = \$7 million)
- What does base tuition increase generate?
  - 3.6% in-state undergraduate: net \$4.3 million
  - 3.6% out-of-state undergraduate: net \$6.7 million
  - Graduate tuition proposal: \$2.1 million
- What cost increases are we facing?
  - 3% merit faculty increase: \$8.6 million
  - 3% merit staff increase: \$8.4 million
  - 2% inflationary cost on non-personal services: \$14.9 million
  - Increase support for enrollment and student services, utility increases, first generation programming, targeted faculty recruitment












## **2019-2020 UVA Student Housing Rates** Peer & Selected Other Institutions Double Room Rate






### **2019-2020 UVA Student Housing Rates** VA Public Institutions Double Room Rate






### **2019-2020 UVA-Wise Student Housing Rates** Peer & Selected Other Institutions Double Room Rate




### **2019-2020 UVa Dining Meal Plan Rates**





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#### MAJOR CAPITAL PROJECTS FINANCIAL PLANS



### **Financial Plan: University Hotel and Conference Center**

- Recommendation of the 2017 Hospitality Task Force and Emmet Ivy Task Force
- Project scope approved by the Board of Visitors in March 2019: 220,000 GSF hotel with 225 guest rooms and 25,000 GSF of conference center space
- Sited adjacent to Ivy-Emmet Parking Garage
- University is pursuing partnership with third party to operate the hotel and conference center
- Estimated project budget of \$100.0 million:
  - Approximately \$80.0 million debt
  - Up to \$20.0 million equity contribution







### **Financial Plan: Inn at Darden**

- Project scope approved by the Board of Visitors in June 2018:
  - 198,000 GSF hotel with 199 guest rooms and 12,000 GSF of conference center space
  - Adjacent 6.5-acre arboretum with event terraces and teaching amphitheater
- Estimated project budget of \$135.0 million:
  - \$30.0 million in gifts
  - \$91.5 million in debt (issued by Darden Foundation)
  - \$13.5 million equity contribution (from Darden Foundation assets)







### **Financial Plan: Athletics Complex Phase II Schematic Design**



- Project scope for Phase II of the Athletics Complex, approved by the Board of Visitors in September 2018:
  - Football Operations Building
  - Olympic Sports Building
  - McCue Center renovation
- Projected cost to complete schematic design and provide additional fundraising material: \$6.0 million funded short-term via debt (repaid by gifts)







#### ESTABLISHMENT OF QUASI-ENDOWMENT

### **Darden School of Business Quasi-Endowment Fund**

The Darden School of Business wishes to invest \$12.2 million into a new unrestricted quasi-endowment fund.



Operating reserve balance at June 30 is approximately \$25.3 million.

- \$8.9 million of unspent endowment distribution
- \$3.3 million from the endowment administrative fee distribution







#### DISINVESTMENT OF QUASI-ENDOWMENT

## **School of Medicine Divestment of Quasi-Endowment Funds**

The School of Medicine wishes to divest the balance in two quasiendowment funds.

- Balances at October 31, 2019
- Sundry Gifts Restricted Quasi-Endowment Fund: \$2.2 million\*
- Adenosine Patent Royalty Unrestricted Quasi-Endowment Fund: \$8.5 million \*




#### DELEGATION OF SIGNATORY AUTHORITY

# Delegation of Signatory Authority for Medical Center Contract

- Board approves execution of any contract where annual spending exceeds \$5 million
- Contract is with Qualivis, LLC, for interim clinical staffing (nurse travelers)
- Projected annual savings are \$1.35 million annually
- Health System Board recommends approval of by the Finance Committee and the Full Board


