## A Brief History

- Delta Kappa Epsilon was established in 1852 (First IFC fraternity)
  - Two fraternities were founded at UVA
- Chi Omega was founded in 1927 (First ISC sorority)

-----

•IFC established in 1934 to uphold:

brotherhood, scholarship, friendship, and moral rectitude

## Today

- •31 Fraternities (16 Sororities)
- •IFC has 30% participation from the male student body
  - 2,000 students in Fall
  - 2,400 students in Spring
  - Average state school involvement is around 8%


