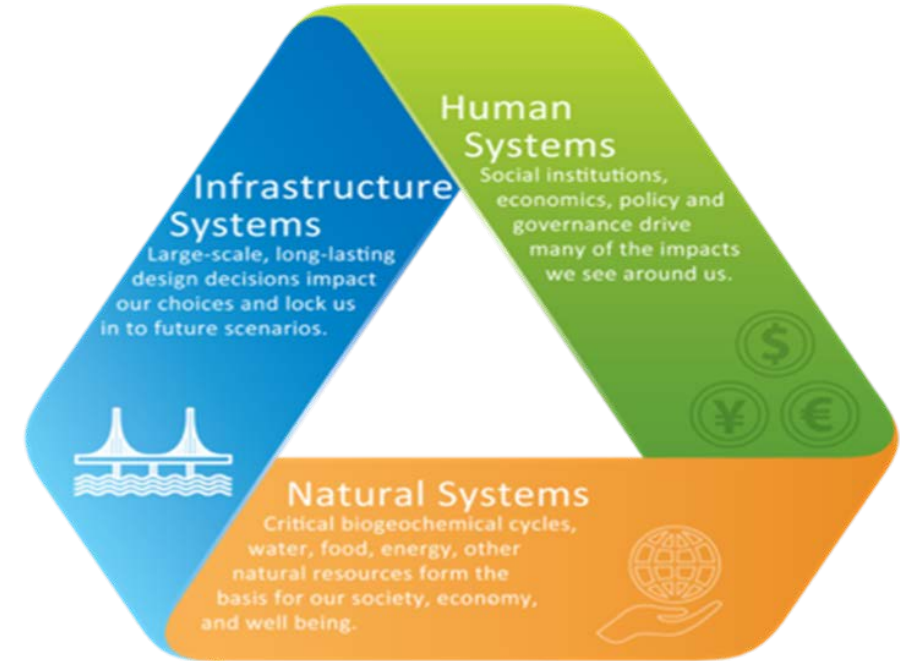

Initial Focus: Coastal Futures – making Virginia the coastal research capital

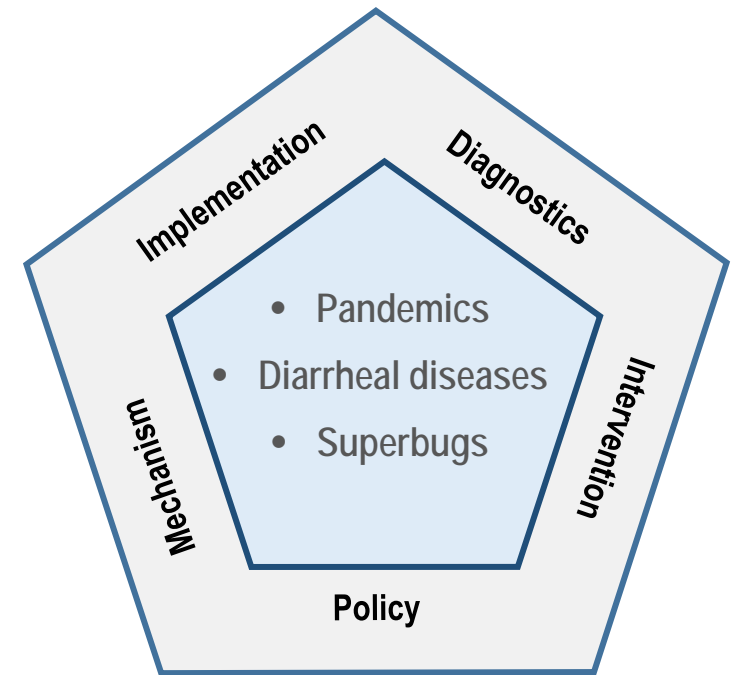


Global Infectious Diseases Institute

Approach:

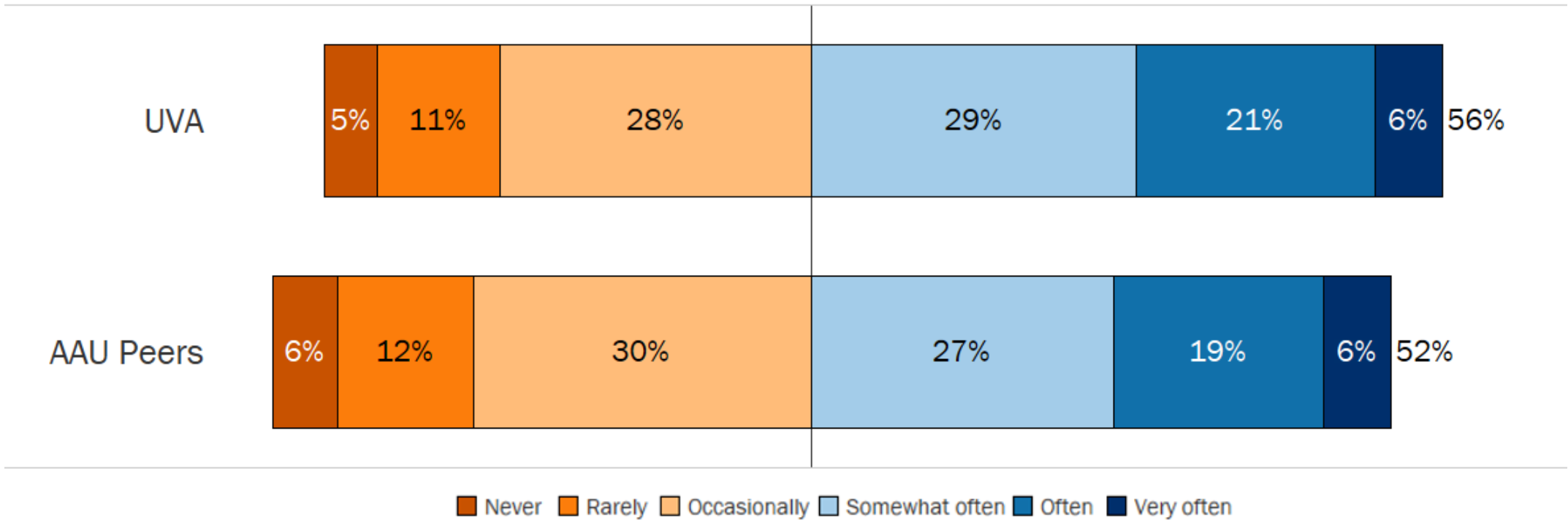
- Nucleate new transdisciplinary scholarly activity in global infectious diseases across Grounds
