

From 1949 to 1990, the German Democratic Republic, also known as East Germany, sought to establish an egalitarian socialist utopia by establishing a one-party communist dictatorship. Under the Socialist Unity Party, the state carried out its policy visions by force. Political dissent and opposition was outlawed with freedoms of expression and movement heavily regulated. In addition, the state's desire for control led to the infamous Ministry for State Security, the Stasi, that spied and kept records on its own people.


