

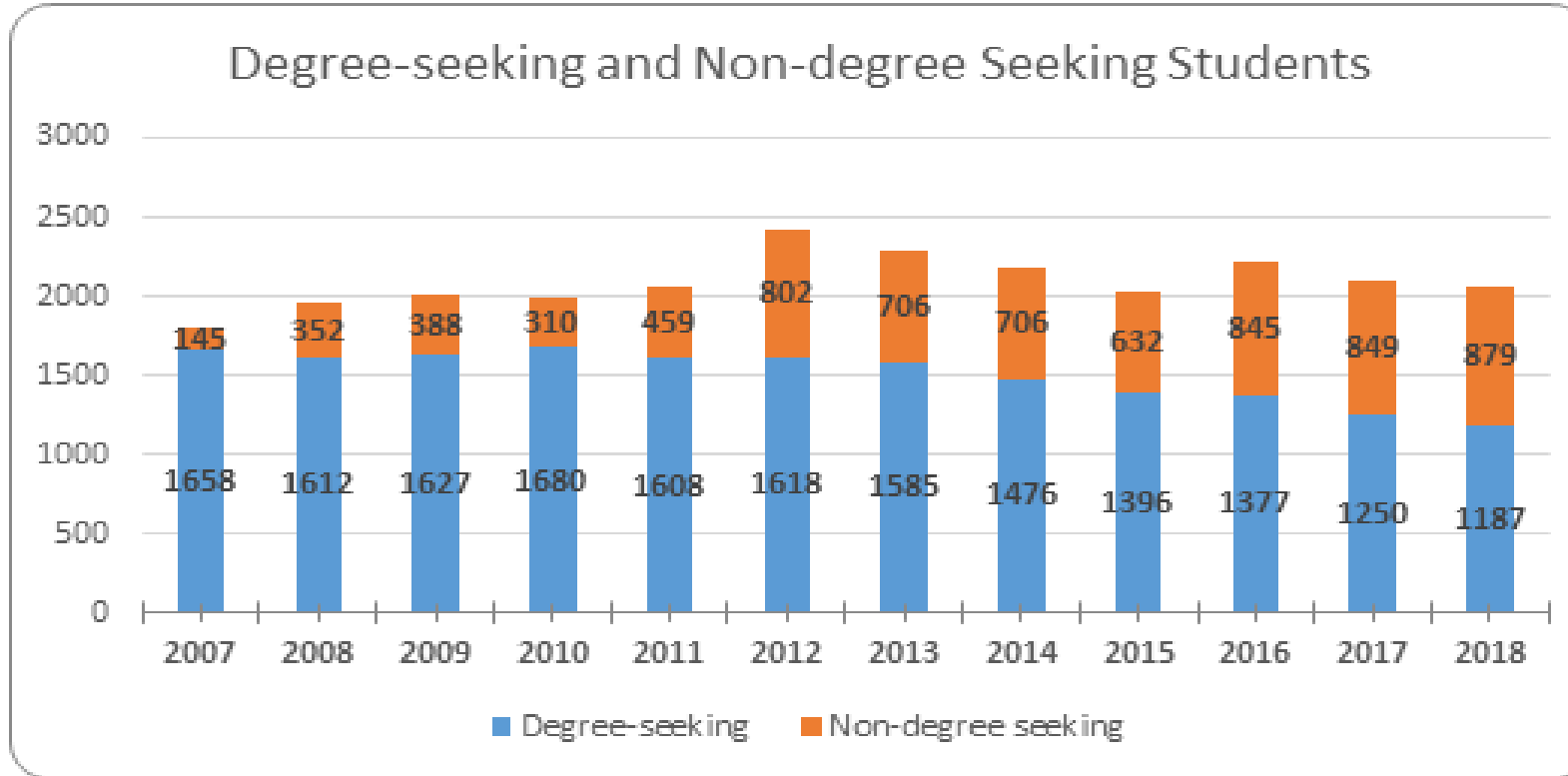

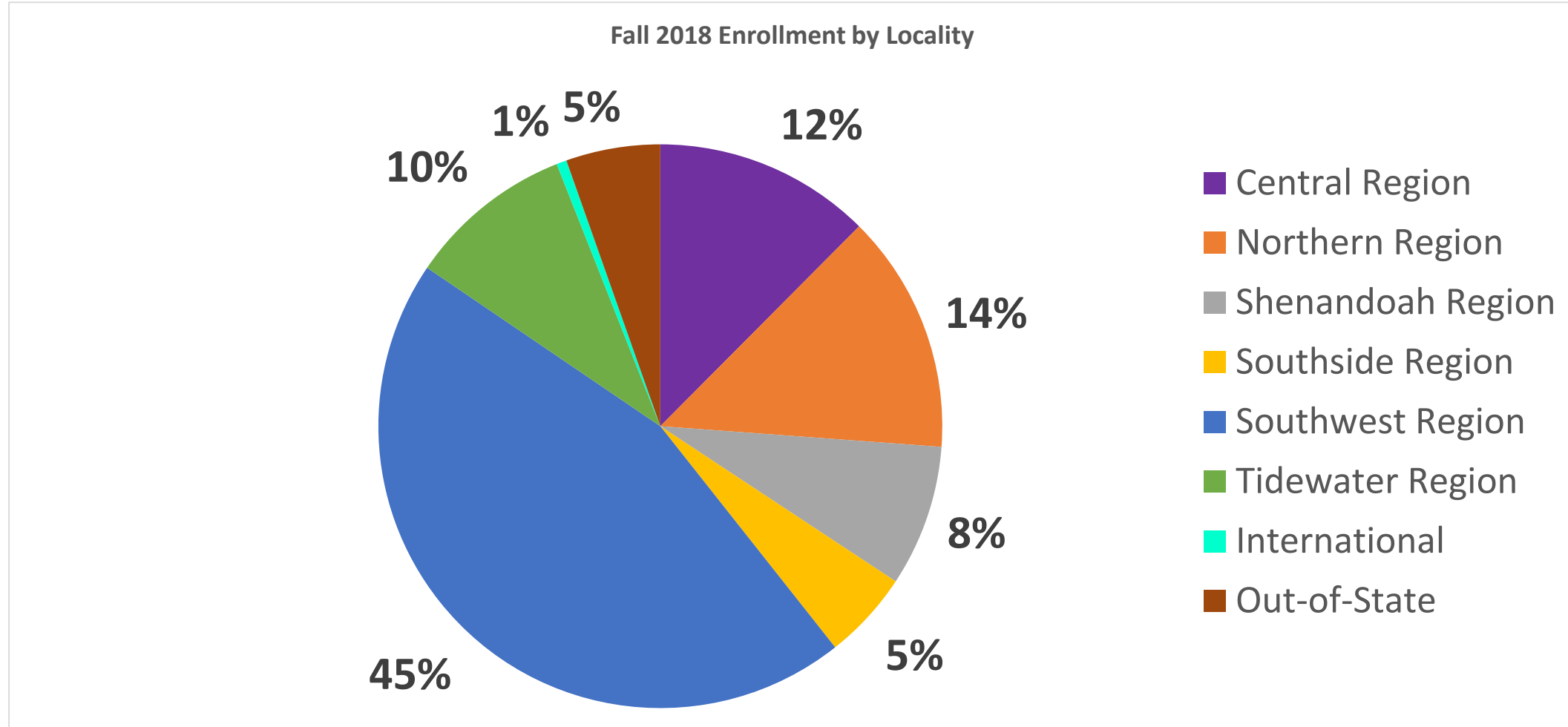

UVA-Wise Headcount by Fall Term

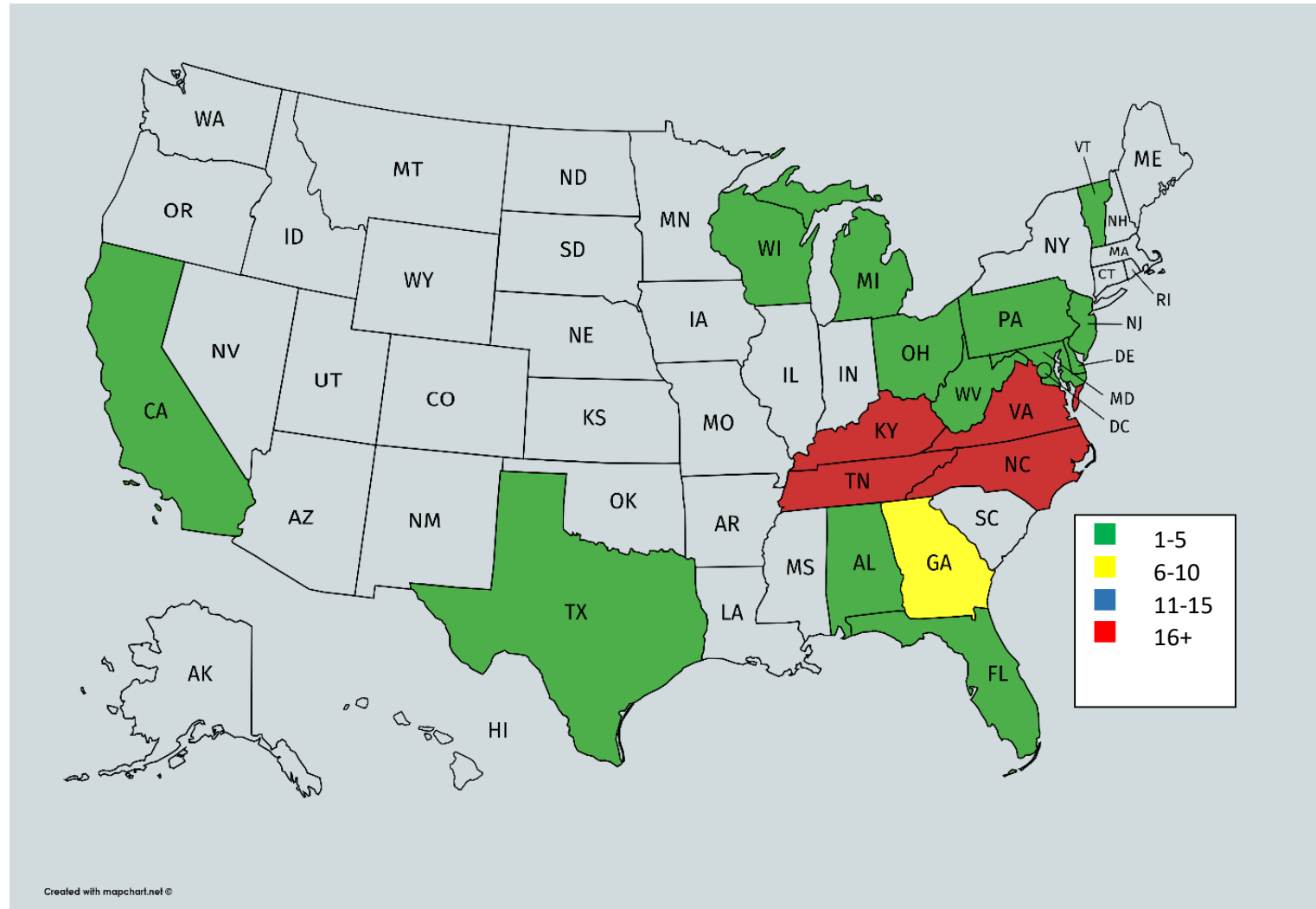

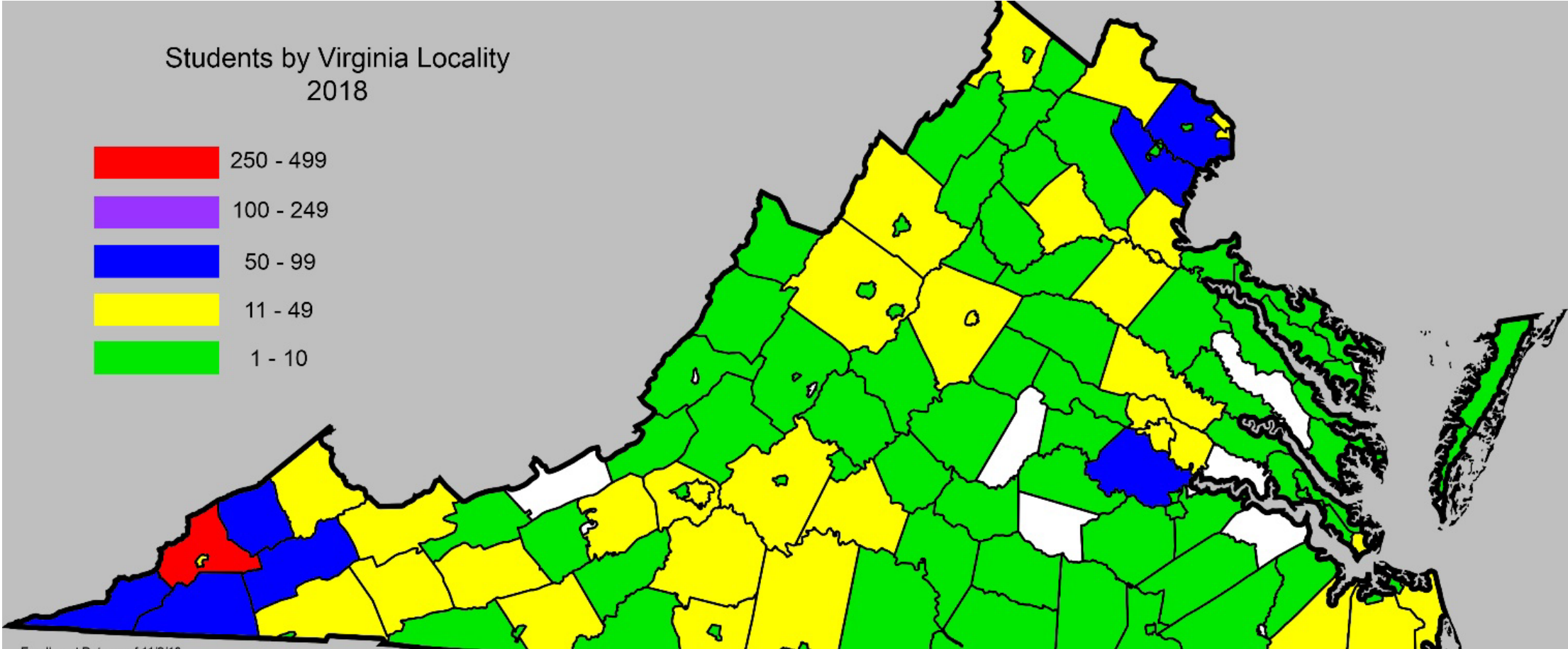
Enrollment by In-State, Out-of-State and International



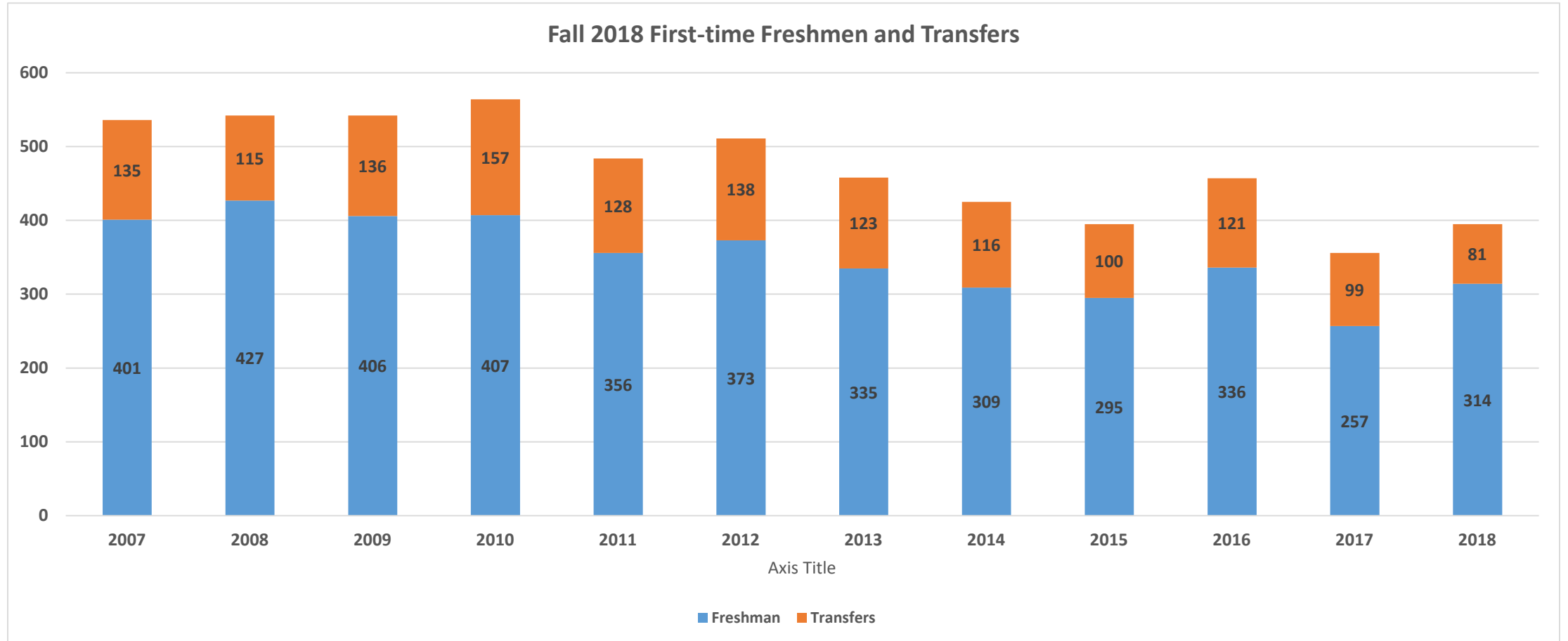
Enrollment by United States and International Localities



Enrollment, Students by Virginia Localities



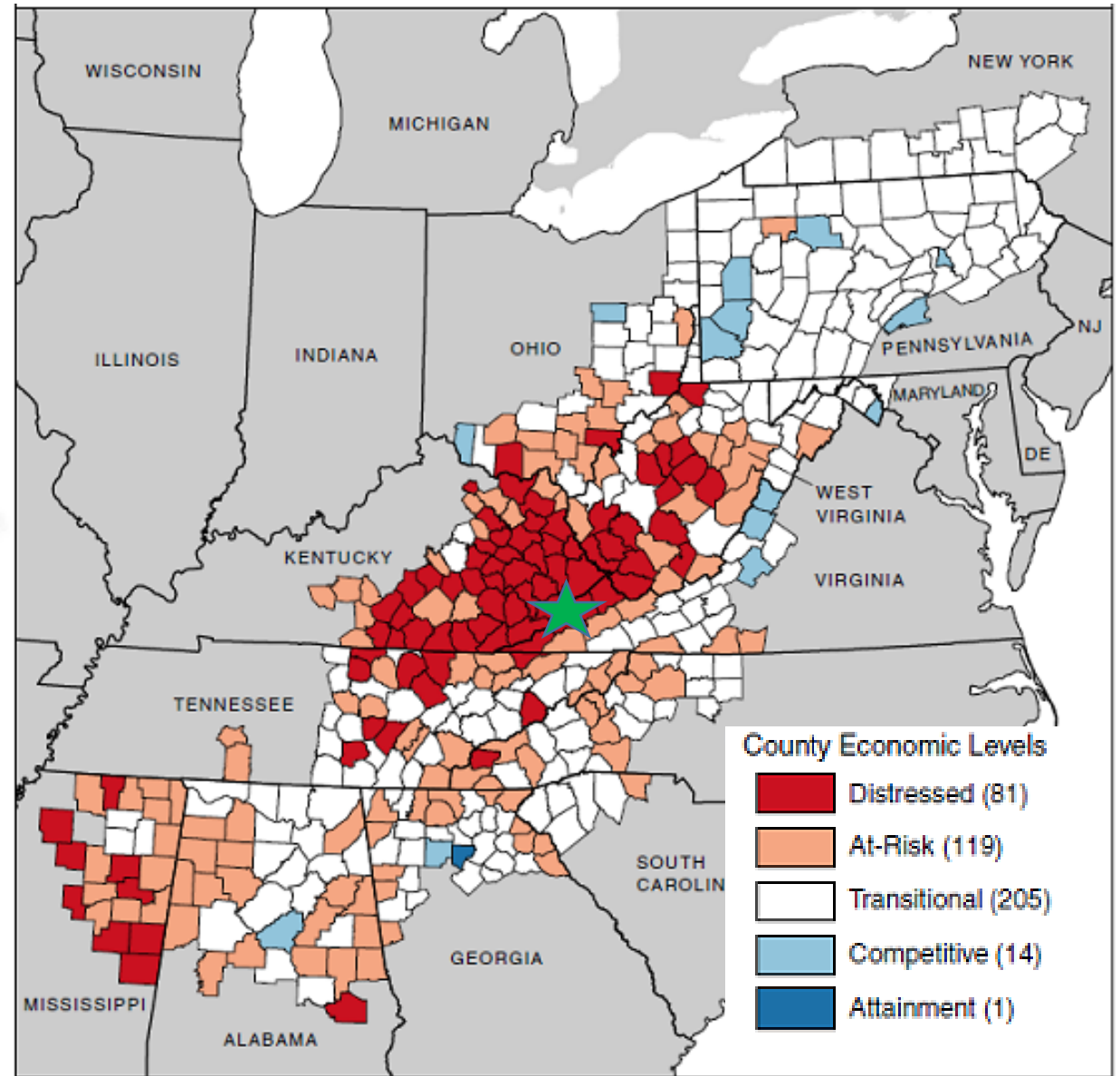
