

Strategic Objectives

- 1. Re-Imagine Curricular Structure with Focus on Competencies to Meet Academic and Professional Goals
- Restructure the Liberal Arts Core to incorporate more interdisciplinarity, broader diversity, and emphasis on essential competencies
- Integrate professional development, experiential learning, and community-based engagement into degree requirements
- Create purposeful and guided pathways that prepare and equip students as they navigate key academic, career, and personal decisions

- 2. Align Program Portfolio with Institutional Mission, Student Demand, and Regional Need
- Evaluate programs for alignment with core mission and develop plan for collaborations (internal and external) and restructuring to strengthen programs
- Explore demand for masters-level education in the region and online degree offerings to reach a broader audience
- Create an action plan for the growth of collaborative programs and initiatives between UVA Wise and UVA



Strategic Objectives

- 3. Invest in Faculty and Staff Recruitment and Development to Achieve Diversity, Collaboration, and Commitment
- Build team, linked to UVA's CTE, responsible for training and support of faculty and staff as they work to achieve educational and inclusive excellence
- Develop teaching fellows program that equips, trains, and supports faculty and staff for the integration of curricular, co-curricular, and extra-curricular programs

- 4. Attract, Engage and Retain Students Who Will Fully Benefit from a UVA Wise Experience
- Create a comprehensive data-informed model of student recruitment and retention
- Develop "academic bridges" from recruitment to matriculation and that link to guided pathways through graduation
- Expand scholarship portfolio to include merit-based scholarships and scholarships for targeted populations

- Adopt a new budget model based on a transparent, consultative, and priority-focused allocation of available resources
- Increase revenue by meeting fundraising, grant acquisition, state and federal funding, and tuition targets









Future Direction for UVA Wise – External Stakeholders Perspective


How can UVA Wise support regional economic growth?
