AGENDA ITEM: II. Fundraising and Campaign Progress Report

ACTION REQUIRED: None

BACKGROUND: Philanthropic cash flow measures actual gifts received by the University during a specific fiscal year. It includes cash or cash equivalents received for philanthropic purposes; it does not include pledges or future support (bequest expectancies, annuities, etc.). Total commitments represent the combination of new commitments (new gifts, private grants, bequests, deferred gifts, donor-advised fund gifts, and non-binding commitments) and new future support (expectancies).

Through May 22, 2023, and with only two months remaining in the final quarter of FY23, philanthropic cash flow for FY23 was over \$300M and total commitments stood at \$463M.

Due to the generosity of alumni, parents, and friends, the University continues to track ahead of schedule in *Honor the Future* campaign totals, and through May 22, 2023, campaign-to-date totals are nearly \$4.6B, with 92% achieved against the overall goal of \$5B.

Ms. Cindy Fredrick, University Advancement Senior Associate Vice President of Engagement, shall provide a report on annual giving, and alumni engagement and participation.
