**BACKGROUND:** Ms. Henry was elected Chancellor of the University of Virginia's College at Wise on December 7, 2012 and assumed office on January 18, 2013. As the College's eighth Chancellor, she is responsible for leading UVA Wise and its constituents in fulfilling its mission of student success and service to Southwest Virginia and the Commonwealth.

Ms. Henry is a biologist with extensive experience in higher education. She spent 16 years in a variety of positions at Florida Gulf Coast University (FGCU). She was a founding faculty member at FGCU, was faculty senate president, and served as a member of the University Board of Trustees. She served as dean of the FGCU College of Arts and Sciences, an assignment that demanded meticulous strategic planning and leadership that allowed the College to grow rapidly while continuing to improve academic quality.

Chancellor Henry earned a Bachelor of Arts in Biological Basis of Behavior from the University of Pennsylvania, where she also minored in Spanish. She earned a Doctorate in Physiology from Thomas Jefferson University. Chancellor Henry is a professor of biology on the UVA Wise faculty.

**BACKGROUND:** Mr. Jeffrey Baylor, who has successfully led enrollment efforts at institutions across the U.S., joined the University of Virginia's College at Wise on July 5, 2022 as the Vice Chancellor for Enrollment Management. He has been serving in the enrollment management field for just over 25 years, first at his undergraduate alma mater, Marietta College in Ohio. From there, he led successful teams in advancing admissions and financial aid strategies and systems at several colleges and universities, most recently at West Texas A&M University.

At West Texas A&M, Mr. Baylor led his team to set a new enrollment record in Fall 2020. He also developed and managed a recruitment plan to sustain long-term enrollment growth and integrated a financial services model to better serve students. Prior to his time in Texas, he led enrollment management teams in Ohio, Florida, and South Dakota, among other locations. In addition to his considerable admissions and financial aid experience, he has worked in student affairs and marketing.
