\$650,000.00 grant

Funding Period: August 2019 – July 2024



- 12 students may receive \$5000.00 per year for four years
- 13 transfer students may receive \$5000.00 per year for 2 ½ years

The Award was Made to Test The Efficacy of Six Approaches to Retaining Financially Needy Students in STEM Fields and Prepare Them for Graduate School or the Work Force

- 1) Freshmen and Transfer Success Coaching
- 2) General Chemistry Coaching
- 3) Close Faculty Mentoring
- 4) Writing in the Natural Sciences
- 5) Research Experiences
- 6) STEM-Based Industry Summer Internship Program

Implementation (the PI and co-PIs)


- The implementation of a five year grant of this magnitude, including this many participants, will require the help of administrative assistant(s).
- The College administration is in the process of identifying resources for a full time administrative assistant to support the Department of Natural Sciences.


