## Role of Trustees and the Board in High Functioning Organizations

- A. Perspective of:
  - 1. College president reporting to board
  - 2. Chair of board
  - 3. Director/trustee on a number of boards
  - 4. Study/teach board
- B. The role of a college/university president is among the hardest leadership roles in the country/world right now (Adm. McRaven)
- C. Best organizations have leaders who are supported by boards that are clear on the two distinct roles.
- D. Boards
  - 1. Are a single unit
  - 2. Serve the university's interests
- E. Essential trustee responsibilities include:
  - 1. Select president
  - 2. Oversight, advice, questions
  - 3. Strategic priorities
  - 4. Financial Oversight
  - 5. Advice and engagement in a crisis
  - 6. Reputation of the university
  - 7. Advise on issues and opportunities presented by the president
- F. High-functioning boards:
  - 1. Do not manage
  - 2. Stay connected consistently over time on key strategic priorities
  - 3. Have open, honest, respectful discussions within the board and with president on key issues
  - 4. Trustees listen well to colleagues and acknowledge the differing points of view
  - 5. Speak with one voice and from one voice
  - 6. Once a decision has been made, support it
