BACKGROUND: Philanthropic cash flow measures actual gifts received by the University during a specific fiscal year. It includes cash or cash equivalents received for philanthropic purposes; it does not include pledges or future support (bequest expectancies, annuities, etc.). Total commitments represent the combination of new commitments (new gifts, private grants, bequests, deferred gifts, donor-advised fund gifts, and non-binding commitments) and new future support (expectancies).

Through December 31, total commitments for FY 2024 stood at \$383M, an increase of 25.3% compared to the previous fiscal year, and philanthropic cash flow stood at \$232M, an increase of 8.5%.

On December 22, 2023, the University surpassed the *Honor the Future* campaign goal of \$5B. Campaign totals continue to increase, and through February 19, campaign-to-date totals were close to \$5.1B, with 101% achieved against the overall goal.
